HEROES AND VILLAINS!

This half term we will be looking at fictional heroes as well as ordinary people who have achieved great things. We will be having visits from real life heroes to talk about their roles and give children the chance to dress in their uniforms! We will also be making 'Healthy Hero' foods and learning about healthy eating.



Children will have the chance to take on the role of their favourite Superhero on our Superhero's Dress Up Day on 4th January 2019.

In our Maths lessons we will be looking at place value to 50 and number and addition up to 50. Homework will continue to be set each week based on our maths learning in class. You could help your child by adding and subtracting when playing board games, out shopping and giving them maths challenges! You could talk to them about the place value of numbers, for example how many 10s and how many 1s can you see in a number. Counting forwards and backwards to 50 will also be a great help to their maths learning this half term.



In our English lessons we will be inventing our own superheroes, writing our own comic strips and writing all about our visits from real life heroes! Any extra writing done at home will be really beneficial and I would love to see it! You could help by getting your child to write about their weekend ensuring they are using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops!



In our Design and Technology lessons we are going to be making our own moving vehicles. Please could your child bring in their own toy vehicles from home (anything with wheels!) so that we can begin to look at how we can start making our own!

Things to remember:

P.E will still be on Wednesdays and Thursdays and this half term we will be looking at Gymnastics. Please ensure all PE kit is named and children have their PE kits in school for PE days.


Please practise minute games with your child and read as much as possible - filling in the reading journal so that we can change their books!
