### Maths

Some of the things we will be learning are:

- calculating with measurements such as weight, length and time,
- fractions and percentages of numbers.

**How to help at home - ask children to calculate percentages when they are in shops, calculate times for journeys or length of programmes and change from £5 or £10.**

### Literacy

This term we will be looking at Macbeth as a stimulus to write stories and plays.

In grammar we will be using brackets, semi colons and dashes for extra information.

### Art and Design

Mrs Gibson will look at Hokusai whose work has been adapted for the cover of our class book 'Kensuke's Kingdom'.

We will be designing and cooking recipes from Mexico in North America.

### Geography - North America

We will be looking at the continent of North America and its place in the world.

The children will be researching the famous landmarks, the animals of the country as well as the sports they play.

### Science

This half term we will be looking at Evolution and Inheritance. We look at how living things have changed over time and how this is evidenced in things like fossils.

The children will be looking at inherited characteristics in families so they may be questioning you about tongue rolling!
